Fatal Industrial Accident in Tooele County

A Juab County man working in Tooele County died this morning in an accident on Stansbury Island. Delta resident, Allan K. Sherman, 56 years old, was killed by injuries sustained in an industrial accident at Bolinder Resources.

Employees of Bolinder Resources notified the Tooele County Sheriff's Office of the accident at about 8:30 a.m. today, Thursday, February 24, 2011. When Sheriff Deputies arrived on scene, Sherman was not responsive. He wasn't breathing and did not have a pulse.

Detectives are investigating the death at this time. They have notified Sherman's family. Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and Mining Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) are both on scene as well.

Bolinder Resources operates a rock products quarry located about seven miles north of Interstate 80 on Stansbury Island.
